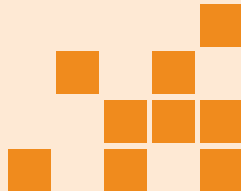
The other benefit of retirement living is that there's no need to worry about the gardens or maintenance of the unit—we will take care of that for you.

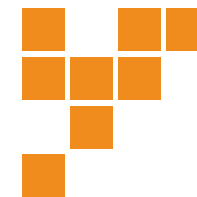
